

Our Dojo (Karate School) Code of Ethics

Parents please go through following items with your children and explain to them what Shihan and all instructors expect from every student. I feel it is important for their behavior and discipline.

1. All Black Belts and instructors are called Sensei (Sen-Say). Master Kim will be address as Shihan (She-Han).
2. All students, especially children must bow properly to Senseis and Shihan. Bowing is to show respect. Children should be practicing at home with parents.
3. Profanity and horseplay in class is absolutely forbidden.
4. Control your temper or the temper will control you.
5. No eating, chewing gum, or wearing a head gear in dojo.
6. All students must be on time for class. Parents help us by help your children to be disciplined children. Please be at dojo 10 to 15 minutes prior to class for aerobic exercise– running in class.
7. When class starts all students must maintain silence.
8. If you must leave during class, then ask permission from Sensei/ instructor.
10. Never misuse karate techniques in or out of dojo. It is ground for demotion. Karate is for Self -Defense only.
11. All students must remember that most important part of karate training at J.H.Kim Karate Institute are: A) Devotion to your family, B) Your work (school) C) Karate training with 100% effort.
12. Promotion to karate rank is a privilege, not a right.
13. Wash your karate uniform (gi) regularly, wear clean gi with dojo patch – wear with pride.
14. Always maintain sportsmanship.
